### **Summary of Job Description**

This position is part of the NorWest Co-op Community Health Intervention & Outreach Team and will provide direct client support for children and youth with complex needs. As a member of the multi-disciplinary team, reporting to the Coordinator, you will use your advanced knowledge and expertise in the mental health treatment of children to provide direct psychiatric consultation to children and youth referred to the IOT team. You will bring expertise in psychiatric assessment, testing and interpretation to this critical role, where you will be a key member of a multidisciplinary assessment team comprised of social workers, peer-mentors, psychologist and an occupational therapist.

You will use your extensive hands-on experience and background in assessing and treating complex clinical problems to support the ongoing education of our team, and further the mental health of children within the IOT team.

As an active and supportive treatment member, you have excellent communication skills, and the ability to work independently and with flexibility. You are a self-directed, highly motivated individual with exceptional leadership, organizational, and problem solving that is able to manage change and deal with a fast paced environment.

### **Qualifications**

- You have a fellowship with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, or equivalent, with a Psychiatric specialty, and are eligible for licensure in the province of Manitoba.
- Working as part of a multidisciplinary team alongside social workers, health practitioners, peer-mentors and a psychologist.
- Knowledge of Motivational Interviewing an asset.
- Awareness of, and sensitivity to, issues of cultural diversity and colonialism.
- Access to a vehicle and valid driver's license.
- Child Abuse Registry and Criminal Records Check required.
