WALK-IN CONNECTED CARE (WICC)

We now offer expanded walk-in services to all of our patients and the surrounding community.

If you or your family members require care for minor health issues, and your Provider is not available to see you, you can walk in to our WICC clinic for care related to:

- bumps, bruises, sprains, strains; rashes, eczema, infected cuts, or minor sores;
- sore throat, earache, colds and flu, cough, fever, or hay fever;
- stomach pain, diarrhea and vomiting, or indigestion;
- headache, new onset back pain, or neck pain;
- birth control, pregnancy testing, or breastfeeding issues;
- urinary infections and sexually transmitted infection testing;
- immunizations.

HOURS OF OPERATION:

Monday - Friday, 12 pm - 7:30 pm

Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays, 9 am - 4:30 pm

When the clinic is closed, please attend another walk-in clinic or an urgent care site for less serious medical issues, or the nearest Emergency Department for serious health emergencies such as stroke, difficulty breathing, heart attack, fractures, major trauma, or significant bleeding.

WE WILL NOT OFFER:

- Narcotic prescriptions and refills (eg. Tylenol 2 or 3, percocet, oxycontin or morphine) or Benzodiazepines (eg. valium, ativan, lorazepam, xanax, clonazepam, or temazepam);
- Insurance or disability forms, pre-op and medical letters;
- Complete, drivers or pre-op physical examinations.
